FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Continued Healing / While Celebrating Discipline

My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing. If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways. – James 1:2-8

As 2025 is in our "rearview mirror" and most of 2026 is yet to come, I hope by now, we are all realizing the path that we are choosing to take, as a congregation, is not the wide, well-traveled, path of the world or the path that many of our brothers and sisters in Christ take on a daily basis. Home groups will be scheduled to begin the week of February 22nd. We also will have another devotional book for each member of the congregation to use as we go through this study together. Please prayerfully consider inviting your friends and family to join us on Sunday Mornings this year as well as the home group you may be attending as we dig into The Spiritual Disciplines. The first week we will look at "The Door to Liberation."

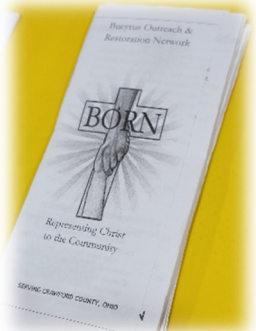
